Detailed Packing Checklist

Essentials:

Beach Safety Tips

Swim Safely:

- Stick to designated swimming zones (lifeguards present).
- Avoid strong currents (red flags mean danger).
- Don't swim under the influence.

▲ Avoid Risks:

- Don't leave valuables unattended (use lockers).
- Beware of jellyfish (monsoon season).
- Stay hydrated; avoid peak sun (12 PM–3 PM).

▷ Lifeguard Posts:

• **Popular beaches** (Calangute, Baga, Anjuna) have lifeguards.

Local Transportation Guide

Best Ways to Get Around:

- Rent a Scooter/Bike (~₹300-500/day, need ID proof)
- Taxis & Auto-Rickshaws (negotiate fares in advance)
- Goa Miles (App-based cabs) Cheaper than local taxis
- Public Buses (Kadamba Transport) Budget-friendly but crowded
- Self-Drive Cars (Zoomcar, Revv)

Important Tips:

- Always wear helmets on bikes (police fines apply).
- Avoid drunk driving (strict penalties).

Peak Season (Nov–Feb):

• Sunburn Festival (Dec) – Asia's biggest EDM fest

- Christmas & New Year Huge beach parties
- Goa Carnival (Feb) Parades, music, floats

Off-Season (Monsoon: June-Sept):

- Sao João Festival (June) Jumping into wells, celebrations
- Bonderam Festival (Aug) Flag parade in Divar Island

Shoulder Season (Oct, Mar-May):

• Shigmo Festival (March) – Goa's version of Holi
